### **Aims and Objectives:**

The aim of the Association is to contribute to the provision of necessary conditions for the development of sports movement and healthy way of life, promoting Association's joint activities for the benefit of its members, taking into consideration principles of good sports practice and traditions.

The Association member has the obligation

- 1) to follow the Association Statutes and to fulfil the commitments assigned to the members by the eligible bodies and leaders of the Association.
- 2) to secure and defend the Association's good reputation, to stand for the aims and principles of the Association
- 3) to pay the membership fee in time
- 4) to use the Association's property carefully and economically
- 5) to participate via the representatives in the regular and exceptional General Assemblies and in case of belonging to the eligible bodies, in their work.

### **ACTIVITIES**

Main Concerns:

In order to achieve its aims the Association:

- 1) Represents and protects its member's interests and rights in governmental institutions and other organizations.
- 2) is engaged together with its members in planning the sports movement, in developing sports democratic structures and sports promotion, organizes training and refresher courses
- 3) Organizes in non-profit way sports activities - sports competitions, sportive events, camps and conventions.
- 4) Develops co-operation with other sports organizations, governmental institutions, municipalities, businesses and other societies and private persons.
- 5) renders its members assistance in supporting the activities of top sportsmen but also participants in local competitions and sports for all activities
- 6) Drafts the Association's sports events calendar plan and works out the competitions' instructions.
- 7) Supports and awards outstanding sportsmen, sports leaders and volunteers and makes proposals to the concerning institutions and persons for awarding the Association's members and co-workers.
- 8) Obtains sports information and organizes its dissemination.
- 9) forms various enterprises and foundations for financial reinforcement of its activities
- 10) favours formation of independent entities to support sports movement
- 11) Gives an impetus to the persons and organisations outstanding in the development of sports movement, assigns scholarships in accordance with valid regulations.
- 12) Organizes paid competitions, accepts donations, concludes business deals with the Associations' properties, organizes lotteries, and concludes sponsor and promotion deals in order to obtain finances for its members' sporting activities.

## **ADMINISTRATION**

### **Structures:**

The leading bodies of the Association are the General Assembly, the Board and the auditing commission. The salaried executive organ of the Association is the Secretariat who in its every-day practical activities implements the decisions of the General Assembly and the Board. The activities of the Secretariat are managed by the General Secretary.



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### **MEMBERS:**

**Number of individual Members:** altogether till 30 000 single members are attracted through member associations

**Number of collective Members:** 15 (sports associations in 15 counties)

### **Kind of Member:**

Legal entities - non-profit sports unions and sports societies of the counties - who accept and fulfil the present statutes and pay annual membership fees can become members of the Association with consideration that there is one member from every county.
